- Either Medical and/or Recreational Marijuana is now legal in over 30 states.
- · State laws vary greatly:
- · NH
- Maine
- Federal law still classifies marijuana as a Schedule 1 drug
- no medical value and highly addictive
- Legalization will likely continue, but guidance and federal law are lagging well behind

Reasonable Accommodations

- · Federal Fair Housing Laws
- Fair Housing Amendments Act 42 U.S.C. 3604(f), et. seq.
- Americans with Disabilities Act 42 U.S.C. 12101, et. seq.
- Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 42 U.S.C. 794



Reasonable Accommodations

- · Exception to the usual rule, policy, or procedure
- Follow a consistent process to address and evaluate requests for reasonable accommodations
- · Always respond in a timely manner
- · Analyze on a case-by-case basis

Reasonable Accommodations

- You may require verification of disability if not readily apparent
- There needs to be a nexus between the requested accommodation and the individual's disability

Reasonable Accommodation

- · Provider may deny a claim if:
- Request was not made by (or on behalf of) a person with a disability
- If there is no disability-related need for the accommodation
- If providing the accommodation is not reasonable (i.e. would cause an undue financial and administrative burden or fundamentally alter the nature of the provider's services)
